#### THE CONTROL CHAMBER AT A GLANCE

1996	The Control Chamber of Armenia was founded
2007	The New Law on the Control Chamber came into force. The Chamber became independent and enhanced with more powers.
2015	Referendum passed on the New Constitution.
2017 –	After the electoral cycle, the semi-presidential system will change to a parliamentary system.
2018	Activities are being undertaken towards the preparation of the Laws on "The Audit Chamber of Armenia" and "Service in the Audit Chamber of Armenia" which will serve as basis for the work of the Chamber.


#### **CHAPTER 13 OF THE CONSTITUTION**

Article 198.

### Functions and Powers of the Audit Chamber

"The Control Chamber is an independent state body that shall perform audit of the legal and efficient utilization of state and municipal budget funds, loans and borrowings received, as well as the state and community owned property, in the field of public finance and ownership."

#### THE CONTROL CHAMBER AND KNIS


